INFORMATION FOR PARENTS AND YOUNG PEOPLE

Thank you for expressing an interest in On the Move, 2019, Stranorlar. We can promise you that the young people will have a great time of fellowship and fun together.

Once we have an idea of numbers and where our young people are travelling from, the DRY Board will circulate further details about transport arrangements.

What is ON THE MOVE?

This is a time together where our post primary aged young people have an opportunity to camp (indoors, of course!) in a church hall. Their time together is supervised by our youth leaders and volunteers from the Diocese and they have time for fellowship and bible teaching. But what sets On the Move aside from other youth weekends is that during the day the young people are out and about in the community where they could be doing anything from painting fences, working in gardens, cooking meals or lifting litter. This year Tidy Towns Stranorlar will help us with some of the tasks. This is a great opportunity to show how we can actually live out our Christian faith in a local area.

Cost

The cost of the trip is subsidised by the Diocese of Derry and Raphoe, but there remains a charge for each young person of 40 pounds/40 euros. *20 deposit is payable by 15th June with the balance payable by 29th June.* 5 pounds/euros reduction is available for siblings who wish to attend. **Cheques are payable to Derry and Raphoe Synod Account**, and the Diocesan Office address is **24 London Street, Londonderry**. Cash should not be sent in the post. As places are limited, we recommend booking early to avoid disappointment. In the event of oversubscription, places will be allocated on a 'first come first served' basis.

A leader from your Parish may be attending as well, and your rector will give you their contact details. Queries which arise before the event should be emailed to dryboard123@gmail.com Should there be an emergency when the young people are away, you can contact Rev Peter Ferguson or Rev Nigel Cairns via your rector.

Young people should bring ***Towel / Appropriate night wear / Toothbrush / Toothpaste / Toiletries / shower gel / Sleeping bag / pillow / inflatable mattress / swimming gear / changes of clothes / older clothes (please note these older clothes are likely to get stained and dirty) / old trainers / coat / Medication / spending money for the Tuck shop / Bible / notebook & pen***
