Sunday 31st May - Pentecost

Read: Read Acts 2:1-21 – Pentecost



The disciples had been doing what Jesus had said -stay in the city and wait. On the day of Pentecost they were all gathered together when somehting amazing happened. A huge sound like a massive gust of wind came into the room, and what looked like tongues of fire landed on each of their heads. This was the Holy Spirit coming to them.
