Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> January 2022 - The Baptism of Jesus



Read: Luke 3: 15-17, 21-22

John the Baptist has been teaching and telling people they need to stop their bad behaviour and turn back to God. Many people thought John was the Messiah they had all been waiting for, but John made sure to tell them he was not – in fact someone who was more powerful was coming – John knew he was doing what God has asked him to do. John baptised lots of people, including Jesus. When Jesus had been baptised, the heavens opened, and God said 'You are my Son and I love you. I am very pleased with you.' God knew what Jesus was going to do while he was on earth, and his baptism takes place at the very start of his ministry on earth – God was pleased the rescue plan was now in motion!
