Today is another special day in the Church Calendar. Today is Advent Sunday, or the first Sunday of Advent. Throughout Advent we count down the days and weeks to a very special day – Christmas Day. We have 4 weeks to plan and prepare for Christmas. In our reading today we hear Jesus explaining that we do not know the time or hour when he will come again, but we should always be prepared because it will happen.
